

Recruitment of NAHS Exec. Directors

Introduction

The National Association for Healthcare Security (NAHS) is a key stakeholder in Healthcare Security with over 600 members nationwide; most of whom hold positions as Healthcare Security Management Specialists in both NHS Commissioning and Provider Organisations.

Since 1994, NAHS has been pivotal in providing advice and guidance, informing on: policy, procedure and training to improve the strategic development and direction of security management in healthcare to its members.

NAHS is associated with the Forum for Healthcare Security in Ireland, has links to healthcare security in New Zealand and has developed links with its counterparts in other countries, including the International Association for Healthcare Safety and Security in the USA.
